INTRODUCTION

It is India's largest cleanliness drive to date with 3 million government employees, school students, and college students from all parts of India participating in 4,041 statutory cities, towns and associated rural areas. Every year, various government institutions plan and execute various cleaning activities through organization of Swachhta Pakhwada. This year, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India and its subordinate offices organized Swachhta Pakhwada during 1-15 August 2018.
