

Admission Procedure

- 1. Admission for first year UG/PG Programme 2023-24 will be in accordance with RTMNU admission schedule.
- 2. Desirous students to take admission in the college must visit the college website www.dbscience.org and read the prospectus carefully.
- 3. Registration, Form-filling, Document-uploading and payment of fees are to be done online by visiting the college website.
- 4. Candidates seeking admission to various classes shall follow the notified admission schedule strictly.
- 5. The application form should be filled in by the candidate properly.
- 6. After successful registration students should retain the hard

- copy of the registration form and have to produce the same alongwith required documents at the time of confirmed admission only.
- 7. After scrutiny of the forms, a merit list will be prepared and flashed on the college notice board and college website. Students are advised to see the college notice board or contact the office for details.
- 8. Principal may call the students and his/her parents for personal interview. Call for interview does not mean a claim for admission.
- The selected students will have to pay the required fee online immediately or within the time limit provided by the college otherwise the admission will stand cancelled.
- 10. The students availing any type of concession must submit the required concession form at the time of finalizing their admission.
- Note: Madmission will be given on duplicate TC. Admission to backward class students will be as per Government rules.
 - The admission rules & fees structure may change as per the directives of Board/University/State Govt.

- 9. Photocopies of Bank Passbook of the candidate (student) for admission having Account Number, local address along with IFSC CODE.
- 10. The students who have completed 18 years of age have to submit photocopy of election card.

Re-admission

Re-admission will be permitted only on availability of seats and as per the condition framed by college.

Refusal of Admission

Refusal of admission is the prerogative of the Principal.

Note

For students from Boards other than M. S. Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or from University following additional documents will be required.

- 1. a) Migration certificate of the last Board/University,
 - b) Eligibility certificate from Nagpur University,
 - c) Verification or mark sheet from the respective board.
- 2. If Migration certificate is not submitted by 31st August, a late fee will be charged as per the university rules.
- 3. Students should keep at least 10 xerox copies of TC and Marksheet with them.

Academic Session

The academic session will commence from as per the University Calendar. Regular classes of all the courses irrespective of declaration of result will start from the same day. The classes of first year will start as soon as the admission process is completed and will be notified on the college notice board.

College Uniform

It is compulsory for all the students to come to the college in uniform.

Attendance Requirement

- 1. Student must attend all the classes (theory as well as practical). Tutorials, Games, Extension activities are also compulsory.
- 2. If the attendance falls below 75% in each subject in each term then the name of the student will be removed from the college and he/she will not be allowed to appear in the College/University Examination.

Medium of Instruction

Medium of Instruction for all the courses will be English only apart from compulsory language (Hindi/Marathi)

Library & Reading Room

The college has sufficient number of books in the library. The students must observe the instructions of Library Department to use the library books. College has the facility of reading room where large number of news papers and magazines are available. Students should make maximum use of the reading room especially in their off periods. They should maintain silence in the reading room. Library Timings: 10.00 am to 05.00 pm.

Code of Conduct for Students

- Students shall seek admission in the college on the basis of merit in the qualifying examinations according to the rules and regulations prescribed by RTMNU, Nagpur.
- 2. The admissions are open to all eligible candidates irrespective of caste, class, creed, gender and nationality.
- 3. The main entrance gate of the college will open at 7:30 am for the students on all the working days for regular classes.
- 4. Any student involved in breaking or damaging any college property will be punished severely.
- 5. Every student should wear college uniform, digital I- card and keep the college I-card with them for any purpose of visit to the college.
- 6. Students should lock their vehicles and keep them in their allotted places.
- Students are forbidden to resort to strikes and demonstration as it will automatically result in the suspension from the college.
- 8. Strict discipline should be maintained in the canteen.
- Junk Food is strictly restricted inside the college campus including canteen.
- Smoking or any types of tobacco products in the canteen are strictly banned.
- A separate seating arrangement has been made for girls and boys in the canteen.
- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the Academic Blocks, which includes Classrooms, Laboratories, Library and the Corridors of Academic blocks.

- 13. To maintain high standard of academics students should attend every lecture, tutorial, practical. Minimum 75% attendance in theory and practical for each student is compulsory. Students having less than 75% attendance shall not be allowed to appear in semester examination.
- 14. Students should be honest and ethical in their behavior on the campus.
- 15. Students should respect all staff, other students and people on the campus.
- 16. Students should actively participate in the academic and extra-curricular activities such as sports, cultural and co-curricular activities and also contribute to the planning, organizing and conducting such activities.
- Every student has to remove the scarf used to cover their face by them at main entrance gate.
- 18. Academic Bank of Credit registration must be compulsory for every student.
- Use of electronic media is allowed for every student for communication with staff.

Medical Examination

- a. Every student of the college shall present himself for medical examination, before the Medical Officer of the college on such date or dates as may be fixed by the Medical Officer in consultation with the principal.
- A student who remains absent from Medical Examination at the appointed date and time without any genuine cause shall be fined Rs.100.00 or such sum as the college may fix.
- c. Without medical examination, students will not be allowed to appear in University exam.

Continuous Internal Evaluation

- The college conducts unit tests during the whole academic session.
 Appearing in the unit test is compulsory.
- b. The college organizes students' seminars, quiz and group discussions in the respective departments.
- c. Besides, the college conducts a full test just prior to the University Examination. Every student has to appear in the test examination without fail. Heavy fine shall be imposed in the case of violation of this clause.
- d. Evaluation Card for every student is prepared which should be duly signed by the parents and brought back to college within 3 days from the date of issue after every Unit Test.
- e. The respective department will conduct remedial classes for academically backward students.
- Some indigenous courses and innovation projects are provided for the advanced learners.

Disciplinary Rules

- a. The activities of every student are monitored through CCTV cameras.
- b. The student found violating any of the above guidelines would be liable for punishment and the decision taken by the college authority shall be final and binding on the students.
- c. The college authority also reserves the right to take any appropriate disciplinary action in any other situation not set in these rules and the decision of the college authority shall be final.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises as per the directives of Maharashtra Government.
- e. Copying during the examination or indulgence in any forgery, impersonation or any other unfair practices during any of the examination or submission of assignments will be liable for strict disciplinary action.

f. Use of mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets by students in the examination hall is strictly prohibited, failing which the student shall be liable for a strict disciplinary action.

- No fees for SC/ST/NT/VJ/OBC as per Govt. of Maharashtra rules of UG & PG.
- If Scholarship/Concession not sanctioned by government during the session then students have to pay full fees.
- The fees structure are as per 2023-24 session subject to any revision by RTM Nagpur University. No fee concession /scholarship for category students who did professional course prior to this course. All the scholarship and concession approved by state/central government and private agencies are available in college.

- v. To provide opportunity to move to higher education in future and to offer bridge courses to certificate holders of general / vocational education, so as to bring them at par with appropriate NVEQF/NSQF level.
