Session-2022-2023

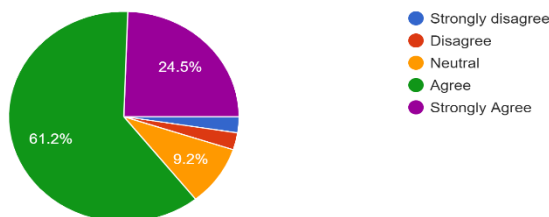

All students were provided the google form on curriculum and their feedbacks were collect in time. The most of the students fill the feedback form & their responses are given below.

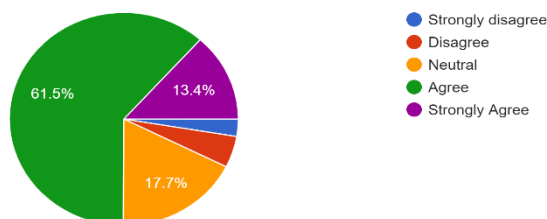

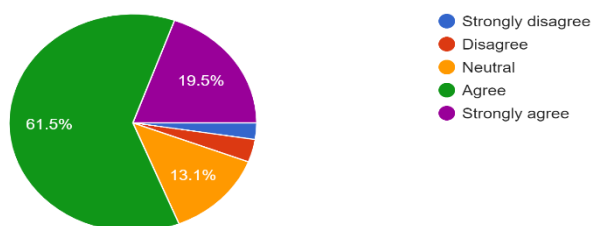

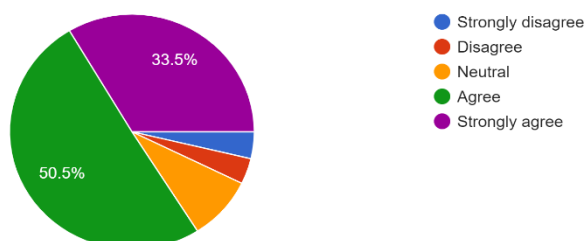

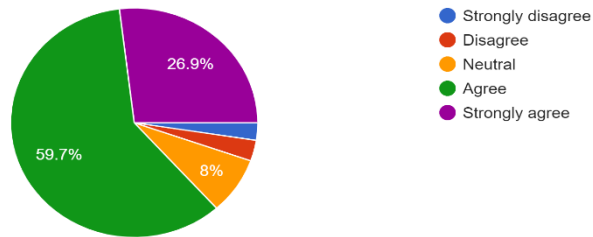

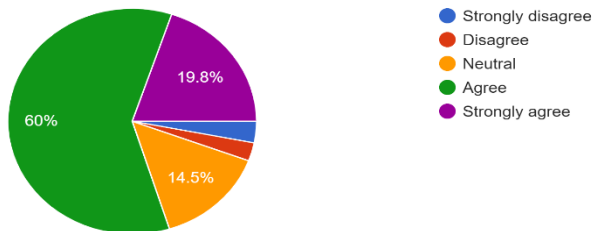

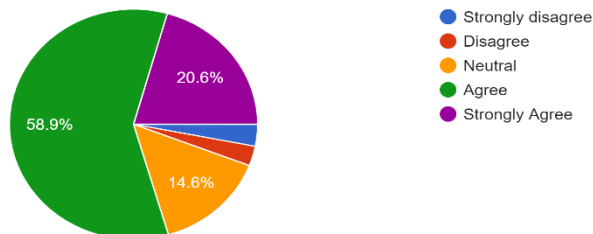

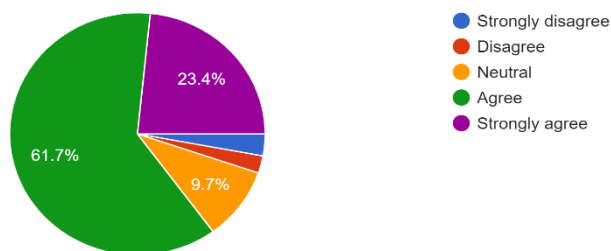

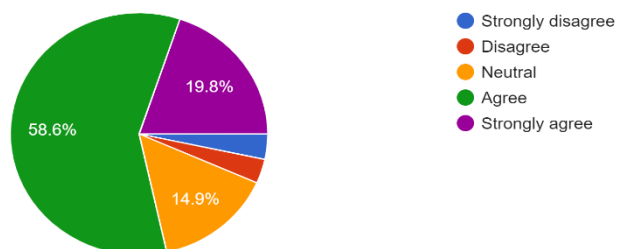

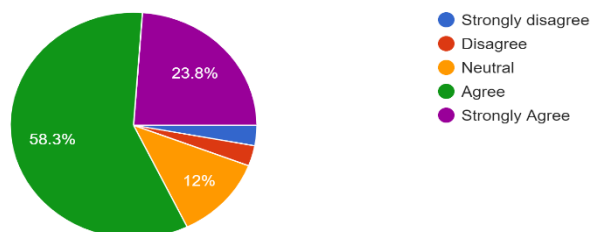

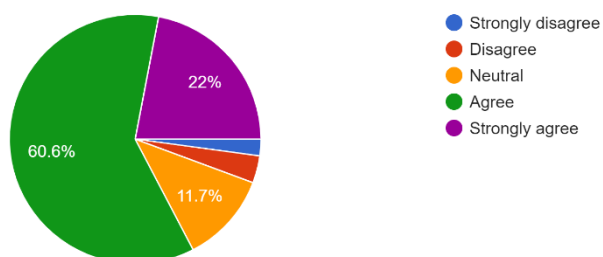

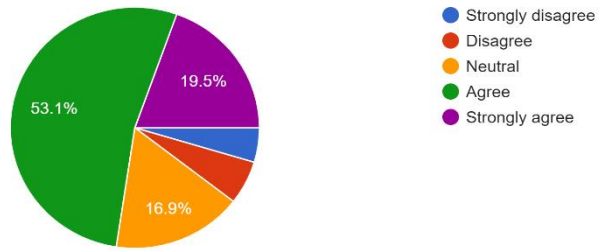

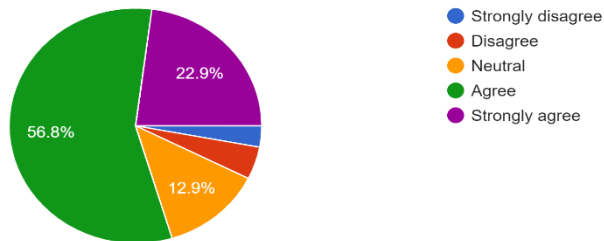

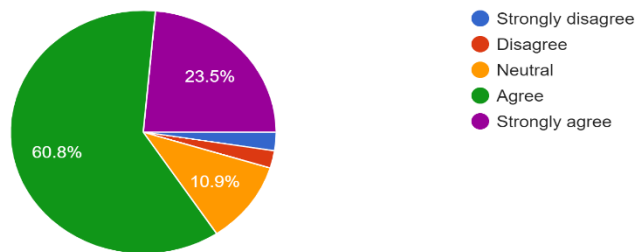

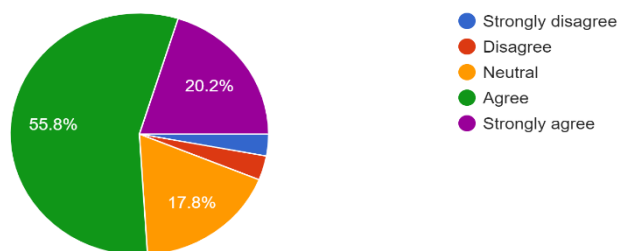

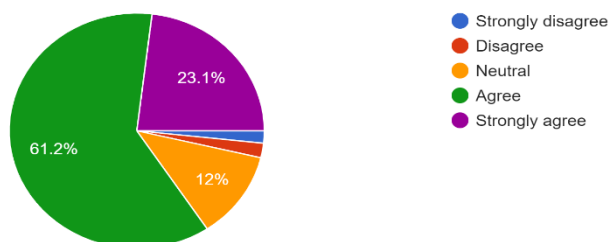
