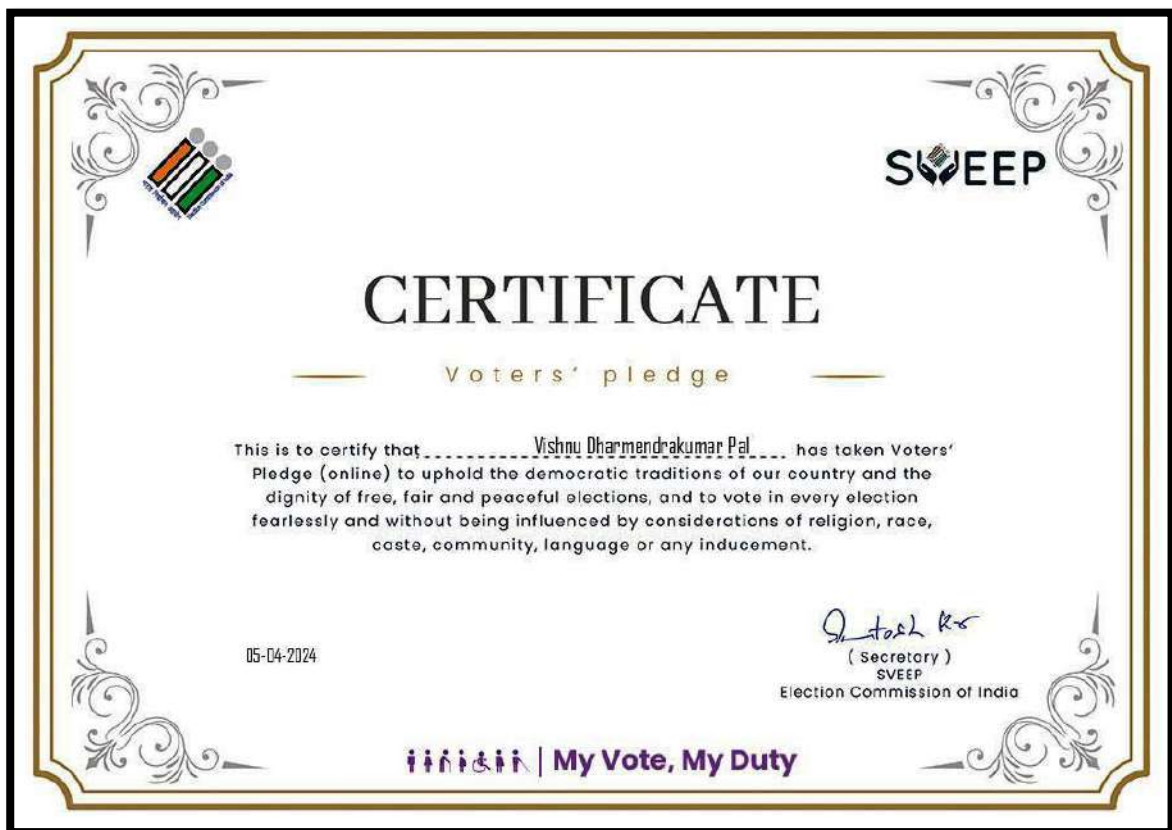

but also emphasized the importance of this noble cause in saving lives. The enthusiastic participation and commitment of all involved parties have set a positive example for future initiatives in the community.



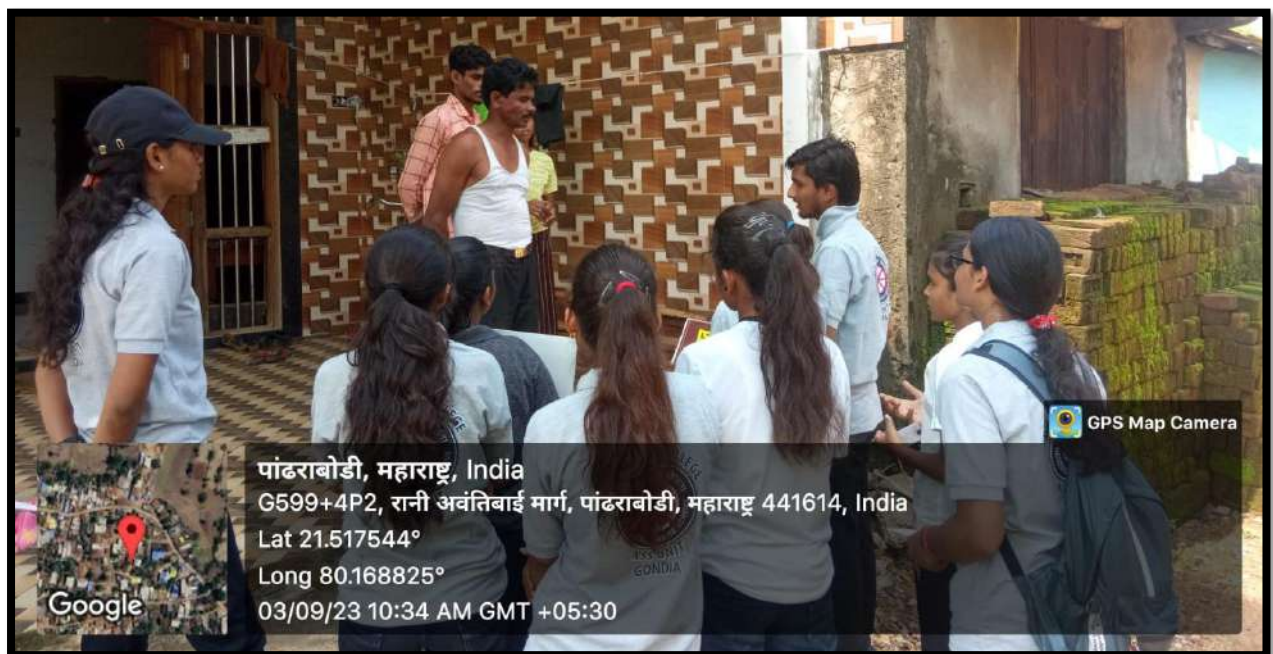
